Semicarbazide hydrochloride is moderately to highly toxic causing somnolence, excitement, or ataxia if ingested. Reproductive effects have also occurred with small doses in laboratory animal experiments. Repeated use may cause weight loss followed by death.

**Additional toxicological information:**

To the best of our knowledge the acute and chronic toxicity of this substance is not fully known.

The Registry of Toxic Effects of Chemical Substances (RTECS) contains tumorigenic and/or carcinogenic and/or neoplastic data for components in this product.

No classification data on carcinogenic properties of this material is available from the EPA, IARC, NTP, OSHA or ACGIH.

Do not allow product to reach ground water, water course or sewage system.

Do not allow undiluted product or large quantities of it to reach ground water, water course or sewage system.

Do not allow material to be released to the environment without proper governmental permits. Rinse off of bigger amounts into drains or the aquatic environment may lead to decreased pH-values.
